

Bedfordshire College- Policies and procedures with regard to the non-arrival of a student

Where a visa application is not successful, the college representative must fax the refusal letter from the Embassy / High Commission along with a copy of the passport details.

The original admission letters from the Embassy / High Commission must be sent to the college by certified post. If a student obtains a visa and does not report to the college by the due date they will be considered as a "non-arrival" and the Home Office will be advised.

According to Bedfordshire College policy, a list is made of all the non-arrival students and their details are sent to the Home Office and the appropriate Embassy / High Commission.
