

Bedfordshire College--Policies and procedures for the non-attendance of a student

Student attendance is strictly monitored. Non-attendance is not acceptable unless validated reasons are given.

According to Bedfordshire College policy, a warning notice is sent to students who stay absent for one week without any notification. Failure to attend classes consecutively for one month (without notice) will result in the student being expelled from Bedfordshire College. The Home Office will be advised of the expulsion.

Students must meet the minimum 80% attendance requirement. If this is not done they face expulsion and their details will be forwarded to the Home Office.
